## **Hairwing Caddis**



## **Recipe and Tying Steps**

- 1. Dry fly hook, #12-18, thread color to match fly, 6/0 or 8/0
- 2. Lay a bed of thread.
- 3. Dub body with desired caddis color (green, olive, cinnamon, tan, black, etc.). Synthetic material will float better.
- 4. Tie one hackle in the thorax, color to match the natural. Hackle barbs should be about one-and-one-half times the width of the hook gape. Apply head cement to thorax.
- 5. Make 2-8 wraps of the hackle through the thorax.
- 6. Shape a head, tie off using your favorite knot, and add head cement
