

Sulphur Comparadun



Hook: 16-24 emerger or klinkhammer (a dry fly hook can also be used)

Thread: 8-0 {70 denier} yellow

Wing: Deer hair (short, flat, fine in bleached or natural color); white CDC tuft; or snowshoe rabbit foot hair.

Body: sulfur yellow dubbing, fine

Tail: medium micro fibberts or antron trailing shuck

Tying Steps:

1. Cut off a 6" length of thread and put aside for step 6, tail formation.
2. Start thread an eye length behind hook eye. Wrap thread about $\frac{1}{4}$ of the shank backwards from hook eye.
3. Cut a small clump of deer hair from the hide. Put in hair stacker to even-up the tips.
4. Attach deer hair with tips extending over hook eye, hook-shank length. Take thread wraps back of hair base to firmly bind down the deer hair. Snip off excess at an angle, then wrap the butts a bit more to prepare for the abdomen and thorax development.
5. Attach fibberts for tail, extending about a full hook length. Wrap carefully to keep them on top of hook shank. Snip off butts.
6. Lift tail fibers up and separate them left and right. Using the 6" thread piece from step 1, loop thread around hook bend, bring the two ends together and use to separate the 2 tail fibers by gently pulling thread to top of hook. Tie down the extra thread piece when tail fibers form a 90 degree angle. Cut off excess thread.
7. Dub the abdomen and thorax with a thin dubbing noodle about 4" in length. Wrap dubbing noodle from base of tail forward to wing. The deer hair butts cut at an angle in step 4 should naturally form a narrow abdomen and a thicker thorax.
8. Bring dubbing noodle to front of deer hair wing, applying dubbing noodle to stand up the wing.
9. Cover hook shank to the hook eye, tapering down from wing to eye, with dubbing, then whip finish and apply head cement.
