



Sculp Snack Jig Streamer

A variant of the Wooly Bugger

Hook: 8-10 jig hook long (FM5130)

Bead: 4.5-5.0 mm tungsten bead

Thread: Depending on color you tie streamer, sz 70 or 140 denier white, black, olive, brown

Body: Medium** UV Polar Chenille (match color with the thread/marabou)

Tail: Marabou (match the color of thread)

Tailing Flash: Flashabou 1/32" in either gold or silver to give contrast/"pop"

Legs: Grizzly Barred Rubber Legs (match color with thread/marabou; can also contrast a little if you would like)

Collar: Ice Dub (match color with the thread/marabou)

1. Add 5-8 turns of 0.015 lead free weight immediately behind bead; be sure to push up tight to bead to secure and can consider super glue on hook shank before adding for extra security
2. Attach thread to hook shank, and secure lead wire with wraps. Build smooth taper from bead back to hook bend.
3. Attach one plume of marabou to hook shank; you want about a hooks length of tail
4. Tie in flashabou just in front of tail fibers; add one strip to both sides of tail and make it the length of the marabou fibers
5. Tie in UV Polar Chenille just in front of tailing fibers; then wrap along the shank of the hook
6. Take 2-3 strands of Grizzly Legs and tie in at the head on EACH side of the hook. There will be 4-6 total strands added that will run along the side profile of the fly. They should be just enough to go from bead to start of marabou. Wrap thread around to secure/tie in and trim excess at near the bead.
7. Add a very thin noodle of Ice Dub to further secure and hide
9. Whip finish and apply head cement/UV Resin to thread.
